**Responding to Dementia: Wednesday 3rd July 2019, 8.00-9.15pm Emmanuel Church Wimbledon**

Alzheimer's and other kinds of dementia affect so many of us. Attitudes are changing, but fear and incomprehension are still the most common responses. As a church we can learn how to respond with love and understanding, in order to support our members and also have a wider ministry to the community around us.

This session aims to give useful information and practical examples to help us relate to people with dementia and support their caregivers.

We will learn how the Gospel impacts our understanding and begin to think how we could better respond as individuals and as a church.
